UNDERSTANDING THE MUSIC MINISRTY



UTMM was birth out of a passion to see musically gifted and skilful Christians harness their gifts and talents in ways that are pleasing to God, eternally relevant, and beneficial to them and to other Believers, both spiritually and physically. There is a growing need for well-balanced scriptural teachings and biblical knowledge on the subject of Christian music, especially among music ministers. You will learn how to posture yourself to be used by God, and how to deploy your gift in a manner that is pleasing to God.

In March 2017, the first edition of The Worship School Lagos took place in the City of Lagos, Nigeria. This 3-day intensive training featured notable music ministers as mentors. Over the years, Minister David Nkennor has hosted numerous other trainings and seminars, like the Worship Continuum, reaching several hundreds of ministers through the WORSHIP IS W.I.D.E Ministry.

Some of the facilitators who featured at these trainings include: Pastor Chris Delvan-Gwamna (Kaduna), Pastor Wale Adenuga, Pastor Gideon Mba, Apostle Ernest Paul, Pastor Ayo Ajani, Minister Sammie Okposo, TY Bello, Olufunmi, Olumide Iyun, Wole Adesanya, Victoria Orenze, Evans Ogboi (UK), Nosa, Tomi Favoured (USA) and others. In 2022, a curriculum was developed to provide a more robust and systematic training on the music ministry for music ministers, and music ministry leaders.

In November of 2022, the first cohort of UTMM began as a virtual class on Zoom, with close to 50 participants from about 9 different Countries. This would be the beginning of a new breed of ministers.


